VWA Annual Meeting

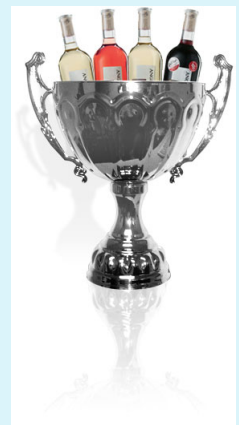


Be sure to mark your calendar for the VWA Annual Meeting on November 15, 2011. This year's meeting will be held at Veritas Vineyard &
